

JOB DESCRIPTION: Classroom Teacher

A. Qualifications:

- The teachers at Lakewood Christian Schools shall have accepted Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior.
- He/she shall be active in a local evangelical church.
- He/she shall have a California State Teaching Credential, or have this qualification waived by the school board. Example (the teacher could be certified by another state or have an emergency credential in CA)
- He/she shall be CPR/AED Certified.

B. Purpose and Scope:

• To provide the primary classroom instruction to students under the direction of the school administrator and school board.

C. Areas of Responsibility:

- The classroom teacher is in charge of the daily classroom and students assigned to the classroom. Specific responsibilities include but are not limited to:
 - 1. Teach subjects and classes as assigned using curriculum, supplementary materials, field trips, special guests, etc., to enhance them.
 - 2. Attend and participate in the following:
 - a. Morning devotions
 - b. Teachers' meetings
 - c. Evening programs if involving his or her students
 - d. ACSI Conventions
 - e. Other meetings as assigned
 - 3. Do supervisory duty before school as assigned, and after school every day.
 - 4. Hold help classes after school as needed.
 - 5. Complete paperwork including the following:
 - a. Report cards
 - b. Records for permanent file
 - c. Inventories of classroom equipment/supplies/books
 - d. End of year debriefing evaluation form
 - e. Records of attendance
 - f. Other paperwork as assigned or requested
 - 6. Building/classroom cleaning and repair:

- a. Be responsible for daily and end-of-year general cleaning of classroom area.
- b. Assist in overall cleanliness of facilities
- c. Promptly report repair needs to the administration
- 7. Maintain proper classroom discipline, taking care of minor problems personally and referring major problems to the principal.
- 8. Be available to any parents or students who wish to have a conference after school.
- 9. Hold conferences with parents of each student.
- 10. Supervise extracurricular activities, organizations, and outings as assigned.
- 11. Maintain a close personal walk with the Lord evidenced by his/her example and spiritual leadership among peers and with students.
- 12. Observes the Matthew 18 principle in conflict resolution. Avoids a negative, critical spirit. Takes problems to the school administrator as necessary.

D. Relationships:

 The Classroom Teacher is responsible directly to the LCS School Principal and accountable to all LCS personnel policies and procedures set forth by the school board.

E. Terms:

• A Teaching position is a 1 year contracted, full-time position. Which follows the academic calendar.
