

Position Focus Lakewood Christian Schools Middle School Science Teacher

A. Qualifications

- Shall have accepted Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior. The spiritual life of the Middle School Science Teacher shall encompass a growing relationship with Christ that shows integrity, graciousness, and dedication.
- Shall be an active member of a Bible-based church, have a mature, godly spirit, a Christian testimony, and accept, without reservation, the Arbor Road Church/LCS Statement of Faith.
- Shall be proficient in the subject they teach. Shall be CPR/AED Certified or willing to become so upon hire.
- Shall have ACSI Certification or be willing to become so upon hire.
- Shall have an active and regionally accredited California State Teaching Credential or be willing to obtain one upon hire.
- Shall be CPR/AED Certified or willing to become so upon hire.

B. Purpose and Scope

- To provide Science instruction to middle school students under the direction of the middle school principal and School Board.
- **C.** Areas of Responsibility The Middle School Science Teacher is in charge of the daily classroom and students assigned to the classroom. Specific responsibilities include but are not limited to:
 - Maintain a close personal walk with the Lord, as evidenced by his/her example and spiritual leadership among peers and with students.
 - Teach subject and class as assigned using the curriculum, supplementary materials, field trips, special guests, etc., to enhance student learning.
 - Regularly implement current and new teaching strategies to improve student engagement, achievement, and behavior.
 - Maintain regular, professional, and helpful communication with students and parents.
 - Take a proactive role in researching appropriate curriculum, software, and resources and communicate needs to the school principal.
 - Attend and participate in teacher meetings, evening programming, ACSI conventions, devotions, and other meetings as assigned.
 - Perform supervisory duty as assigned.
 - Be available to parents or students after school as needed.



- Maintain proper classroom discipline. Handle minor problems personally and refer major problems to the principal.
- Complete necessary paperwork including but not limited to:
 - Report Cards
 - Records for permanent file
 - Inventories of classroom supplies
 - End-of-year forms
 - Records of attendance
 - Other paperwork as assigned
- Maintain building and classroom
 - General cleaning of classroom and middle school areas.
 - Assist in the overall cleanliness of facilities.
 - Promptly report repair needs to the administration.
- Supervise extracurricular activities, organizations, and outings as assigned.
- Observe the principles of Matthew 18 in conflict resolution and involve school administration as necessary.
- Complete other duties as assigned.

D. Relationships

 The Middle School Science Teacher is responsible directly to the LCS Middle School Principal. He/she is accountable to all LCS personnel policies and procedures.
