Position Focus: Middle School Math Teacher

A. Qualifications

- Shall have accepted Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, with a spiritual life that encompasses a growing relationship with Christ, showing integrity, graciousness, and dedication.
- Shall be an active member of a Bible-based church, have a mature, godly spirit, a Christian testimony, and accept, without reservation, the Arbor Road Church/LCS Statement of Faith.
- Shall be proficient in the subject they teach.
- Shall be CPR/AED Certified or willing to become so upon hire.
- Will have ACSI Certification or be willing to obtain it upon hire.
- Shall have an active and regionally accredited California State Teaching Credential or be willing to obtain one upon hire.
- Shall be proficient or willing to learn content-specific skills, knowledge, and application.

B. Purpose and Scope

- To provide **Math** instruction to **6th-8th-grade** students through a Christian Worldview under the direction of the school administration and School Board.

C. Areas of Responsibility - Specific responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Teach subject and class as assigned using the curriculum, supplementary materials, field trips, special guests, interactive methods, and personalized learning opportunities to enhance student learning.
- Be willing to help students with after-school questions through after-school offerings.
- Regularly implement current and new teaching strategies to improve student engagement, achievement, and behavior.
- Introduce and reinforce the growth mindset in all students.
- Demonstrate outstanding presentation, interpersonal abilities, and communication with all students, parents, team members, and community members.
- Take a proactive role in researching appropriate curriculum, software, and resources, and communicating needs to the school principal.



- Attend and participate in teacher meetings, evening programming, ACSI conventions, devotions, and other meetings as assigned.
- Be responsible for daily and end-of-year general cleaning of the classroom.
- Maintain proper classroom discipline, address minor problems personally, and refer major issues to the principal.
- Complete paperwork, including report cards, records for permanent files, inventories of equipment/supplies/books, end-of-year debriefing evaluation forms, records of attendance, and other paperwork as assigned or requested.
- Promptly report repair needs to the administration.
- Supervise in-school and extracurricular activities, organizations, and outings as assigned.
- Observe the Matthew 18 principle in conflict resolution.
- Avoid a negative, critical spirit.
- Other duties as assigned.

- The **Middle School Math Teacher** reports directly to the **Middle School Principal**, Head of School, and School Board and is accountable to all LCS personnel, policies, and procedures set forth by the school board.
